We kindly invite you to participate to **The 10th International Conference on Finite Fields and their Applications Fq10**, that will take place in Ghent, Belgium, July 11-15, 2011.

Started in 1991 with the organisation of the First International Conference on Finite Fields and their Applications in Las Vegas, USA, Fq10 wishes to continue the tradition of gathering a great number of researchers on finite fields.

Conference topics: include, but are not limited to:

- **Field-theoretic aspects of finite fields:** structure of finite fields, normal bases, polynomials, primitive elements, number-theoretic aspects of finite fields, exponential sums, arithmetic theory of function fields.
- **Computational aspects:** algorithms and complexity, polynomial factorization, decomposition and irreducibility testing, sequences and functions.
- **Applications:** algebraic coding theory, cryptography, affine and projective geometry over finite fields, algebraic geometry over finite fields, finite incidence geometry, designs and configurations, difference sets, combinatorics, generalisations of finite fields.
